








## Percentage Change in Median Household Income by Race/Ethnicity, Illinois 2007 to 2013 (Adjusted to 2013 Dollars)



- When adjusted for inflation, all groups saw a decline in their household income between 2000 and 2013.
  However, Latinos and African Americans saw a decline of 15.3% and 15.5% respectively
- This time period reflects the disproportionate impact of the recession on African Americans and Latinos.











